The Samoa Association of San Diego (TSASD) is proud to announce its third annual scholarship award to assist in potential recipient's educational goals for a successful future. The Association was established in 2019 to promote and enhance understanding of the Samoan culture, custom, tradition and language. One of its goals is to provide resources for postsecondary education. This scholarship can be used towards tuition for;

- Community, trade or vocational school
- Undergraduate College, University

Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis with consideration given to academic achievement, letters of recommendations, essay and community service

# **Required Documents**

- Complete signed and dated The Samoa Association San Diego Scholarship Award and Application Form
- **One photograph** of your most recent wallet size headshot, in color or black and white, copies are not accepted
- Letter of Acceptance from the college/university, OR Registration Letter from the community college/ trade/vocational school
- Transcripts:

High school seniors must submit their high school transcripts and undergraduate applicants must submit their college/university transcripts

Community college, Trade and Vocational applicants must submit their transcripts **OR** if any, for applicants who are going back to school after a period of time off from their studies Official transcripts of the most recent Semester **Spring 2024**, to be sent by mail in a **sealed envelope or via eTranscript <u>directly</u> from the school to the Scholarship committee <u>info@tsasd.org</u>** 

• Essay:

Tell us about yourself, any leadership roles in school or college or community, volunteer work within the community, civic involvement, youth groups, future contributions to the Samoan and the Pacific Islander Communities and how you want to give back to the community through leadership service, volunteer, tutoring etc. Promoting your culture for example, ta'i le sua, ava ceremony, lauga, interpreting for the non-Samoan speakers, saofai ceremony, village council meetings, women's committee (in Samoa), aumaga, siapo, tattoo, carving, weaving, learning island art etc

- **Proof of ethnicity,** for example; applicant's birth certificate, parent's and or grandparent's birth certificate
- **Two most recent Letters of Recommendation**, signed and dated from i) academic professor, advisor, counselor and ii) a community leader, minister, employer **OR** iii) For back to school applicants, Two most recent Letters of Recommendation from a community leader/minister or employer addressed to the following:

# <u>Eligibility</u>

- Student of Samoan ancestry
- Resident of the San Diego County within the last 12 months can attend school/college from home
- Minimum GPA 2.5
- In addition, applicants must meet **ONE** of the following requirements:
  - 1) Enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college/university OR

2) Employed and enrolled as a part-time student, minimum of halftime or 6 units at an accredited college/university community college/trade/vocational school (need documentation from employer and college/university/community/trade/vocational school).

All application and required documents must be post dated by May 3rd, 2024 to the following address:
